



Safety Pong



The Safety Pong Tournament will be played during **CHOP Research Safety Day** each year. It will be held in the Colket Translational Research Building (CTRB) first floor conference rooms.

General Information

Safety Pong is a game in which players throw a ping pong ball across a table with the intent of landing the ball in a cup on the other end. The game typically consists of two teams, with two players on each team, and multiple cups set up, in triangle formation, on each side. To win, players must land the ball in all of the other team's cups.

- Teams of two can sign up to play during specified time slots
- Single elimination
- Preliminary rounds played with 3-cup format
- Advanced rounds played with 6-cup format
- Championship game with standard 10-cup format

The two winning players will each receive a prize, trophy, and ultimate bragging rights.

House Rules



First Round and Semi-Finals

1. Flip a coin to see who will shoot first
2. No leaning beyond the line or you lose your turn
3. No bouncing the pong ball
4. No blowing the pong ball out of the cup
5. No deflecting the ball
6. You must put on the item indicated on the cup the ball lands in (e.g. lab coat, safety goggles)
7. If both players on a team each make a cup, it is still the other team's turn

Championship

1. Flip a coin to see who will shoot first
2. No leaning beyond the line or you lose your turn
3. No bouncing the pong ball
4. No blowing the pong ball out of the cup
5. No deflecting the ball
6. One re-racking of the cups
7. You must put on the item indicated on the cup the ball lands in (e.g. lab coat, safety goggles)
8. If both players on a team each make a cup, it is still the other team's turn
9. If both teams make the last cup, it will be shoot until you miss
