



ADOLESCENTS AGES 8 TO 18 YEARS NEEDED FOR FOOD ALLERGY STUDY

WHAT ARE THE GOALS OF THIS RESEARCH STUDY?

The goal of this research study is to identify and measure anxiety symptoms in children with food allergy.

WHO CAN BE A PART OF THIS RESEARCH STUDY?

Children ages 8-18 with an IgE-confirmed food allergy and a parent can participate.

WHAT WILL PARTICIPANTS BE ASKED TO DO?

Children and a parent will be asked to complete electronic questionnaires online or during a regular appointment at the Food Allergy Clinic. The time commitment for the study is 40 minutes for a parent and 20 minutes for a child. Certain families will be asked to complete additional questionnaires two weeks after their first round. Participants will not be compensated for their time.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

Participants will receive no benefits for taking part.
